- Strong negotiating, analytical, written and organizational skills.
- Strong computer skills (MS Word, Excel, Outlook and various in-house claims systems –Guidewire, Genius, ImageRight is a plus).
- Multiple state adjuster licenses a plus.
- Experience with the handling of construction site accident and construction defect claims and litigation (defense and coverage) is a significant plus.
