

Endurance Tailors Multi-Year WindLock[®] Contract for Meridian Energy Australia

Innovative Transaction Using Vaisala's Weather Data Will Reduce Earnings Variability from Renewable Energy Production

PEMBROKE, Bermuda – February 10, 2016 – Endurance Specialty Holdings Ltd. Endurance Global Weather, via its customized WindLock[®] product, provides financial risk protection for companies seeking to manage the wind variability of operating assets as well as assets in development. This transaction will provide Meridian financial protection against the risk of low annual earnings from price and volume variability at Meridian's Mt. Millar wind farm in South Australia.

Millar, where there is no public weather station at the relevant hub height, we are able to reduce potential basis risk for Meridian."
