Main areas of responsibility:

AVP, Network Engineering & Operations is responsible for the architecture, design and operations of all networking and telecom technologies.

The ideal candidate would be responsible for managing and maintaining organizational effectiveness and efficiency of an onshore-offshore team that supports all networking and telecom technologies on a 24x7 basis.

Deep technical knowledge of the core technologies is required in addition to the capability to be hands on if and when required is an expectation of this role. Certifications in core technologies are a benefit.

Essential Job Functions:

The Manager of Network and Systems Engineering is accountable for the following functions:

- Network Engineering & Operations Management:
 - Oversees the activities directly related to Network and Telecom Strategy, Engineering, and Operations, including but not limited to: network design, support, maintenance, lifecycle management, and security. Responsible for output and performance of the Network and Telecom functional areas.
 - Establish and implement multi-year strategic plan for Network laying out plan for all major technologies



- Plans and manages the division's strategic activities and timelines, coordinating with other infrastructure division leaders as needed.
- Drive on time, on budget delivery of project insuring portfolio
- Manages activities directly related to the monitoring of the Network and Systems availability, capacity, and performance. Drive maturation of monitoring and response within the organization. Focus on continuous optimization of network operations through standardization, automation, and process improvements. Establish/optimize KPIs and utilize reporting to drive improvements
- Leads and manage the troubleshooting and solution provisioning for network related issues with a focus on RCA and corrective and preventative actions and process improvement
- Assist the head of Infrastructure in managing and coordinating the department's financial and budget activities to fund operations, maximize investments, and increase efficiency.
- Establishes and implements networks projects, policies, procedures, and objectivesconferring with senior/executive leadership and staff as necessary.
- Determines staffing requirements: interviews, hires, and helps train new employees or oversees those personnel processes. Leverages the capabilities of new and existing talent.
- Manages vendor relationships: Maintenance & Support contracts and team engagement.

- Administrative and Management tasks

- Maintains professional and technical knowledge by attending educational workshops, reviewing professional publications, establishing personal networks, benchmarking state-of-the-art practices, and participating in professional societies.
- Creates detailed planning that reflect the impact of requests and proposed changes to Capex/
 Opex spend required to support proposed technology changes/assumptions.
- Possesses strong verbal and written communication skills, including ability to distill complex issues quickly, effectively communicate strategies, and summarize key points/implications.
- Demonstrates strong project and process management skills and ability to manage multiple competing projects/priorities simultaneously.
