Main areas of responsibility:

The **AVP**, **Data Warehousing Operations** will be responsible for managing operations of the global data warehousing environment. This includes overseeing legacy warehouse support, and buildout of the enterprise data warehouse.

- Provide senior managerial and technical leadership to develop, maintain and support the
 entire data warehousing platform with a focus on deliverables including projects, system
 enhancements, defects, performance, availability and scalability
- Develop and enforce operational procedures for the development and maintenance of ETL streams, databases and data extracts in the form of design and development best practices, standard operation procedures and operating controls. Produce automated monitoring and control reports for transparency and compliance. Technologies in use are Informatica and SQL Server Integration Services (SSIS)
- Enforce and control all design and development procedures, produce automated monitoring and controlled reports for transparency and compliance. Conduct lesson learned and apply principles of continues improvement techniques to improve predictability of application/job runs as well as the information accuracy.
- Establish, deploy, control and report on:
 - Operating procedures for code and data object promotion, database backups, security access and disaster recovery capabilities
 - Operating procedures including Job Schedules, SLA Measurements, Performance Tuning, Production Support schedules and integration with IT operations



- Develop budget and resource allocation and control models for internal and external, technological and human resources
- Manage recruiting process together with HR and external vendors to ensure proper staffing levels using just in time approach to maximize budgeting efficiency
- Establish relationships with technology product vendors and resource providers to have access to tools and skilled resources as needed
- Provide off hours support to the team as needed

Other important tasks include:

- Own the successful implementation of various data integration initiatives
- Lead a high-performing development and implementation team recruiting, training, coaching and developing effective leaders and staff
- Ensure teams have appropriate support to meet goals and ensure that project risks are identified, mitigated and communicated to stakeholders
- Champion adoption of DW systems/tools/processes where appropriate
- Coordinate with the CIO, SVP of Data and Analytics, Chief Data Architect and other technology leaders to identify and prioritize key data warehouse deliveries

Minimum Qualifications:

- 10+ years' Data warehouse and data integration experience, with increasing responsibilities for data management and direct management of a major IT operation preferably in a large-scale data warehouse environment.
- 10+ years in IT management, with a background in ITIL or similar foundational technology platform discipline.
- 7+ years' experience as an ETL Developer and/or Team Lead
- Experience with SSIS and/ or Informatica ETL tools
- Experience establishing and enforcing production operations methodologies
- Proven track record in developing, deploying and maintaining Transaction Databases, Data Warehouse / reporting / analytics technologies and Analytics Management systems in P&C Insurance Industry.
- Deep understanding and appreciation for both business and technology components of information management in insurance and financial services industry
- Proficiency with SQL (any vendor)
- Experience with techniques and approaches to handling large amounts of frequently updated data
- Team-building, recruiting, and talent management skills are essential. Management of a distributed team
