- 3. Collaborate closely with the Sompo International European-based Legal team, global Legal & Compliance Department and other business units (Management, Underwriting, Multinational Team, etc.)
- 4. Implement and oversee a best-in-class compliance framework and coordinate reporting and/or ensure local offices report as required.
- 5. Provide compliance support to Senior Management and key functions in Continental Europe as the business expands and growth anticipation.
- 6. Undertake compliance monitoring across EU region.
- 7. Act as the main point of contact for compliance issues as and when they arise in the EU region.
- 8. Assist in updating of the annual compliance monitoring plan.
- 9. Communicate with regulators as necessary and remain abreast of regulatory developments of impact to Sompo International.
- 10. Provide a day-to-day point of contact for compliance queries from Company branch offices.
- 11. Assist and coordinate regional compliance training.
