With a recent change of structure (newly formed central PPA team) a new opportunity for a role to 'Business Partner' with the UW teams has arose. This role requires an individual who has a high level of competence and confidence in understanding, interpreting and communicating financial performance to both finance and non-finance professionals.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Development of regular reports and analysis for each of the UW Business Units ensuring coordination with the rest of the PPA team
- Strong excel / report builder with experience of bringing together data held in different systems to output easy to read and digest KPI's / reports as required
- Building a relationship with each of the UW heads / teams and ensuring they have access to required information to help develop performance analysis



- Analysis of underwriting performance vs plan and (where relevant) prior year at various different reporting levels and responsible for sharing this information with UW teams, finance, CEO & CUO
- Responsible for producing the quarterly forecasts and annual budgets working closely with the UW leads and other stakeholders, keeping Head of International PPA informed as required
- Working seamlessly with the Global Insurance PPA team to ensure consistent approach to all standardised reporting to enable quick and easy consolidation
- Support Head of International PPA in various aspects of coordinating team activities as required
- Assist Head of International PPA in performing competitor analysis and preparing presentations as required
- Any other ad hoc duties as required
