Responsibilities include:

- Contribute to the execution of the internal audit plan, participating or leading underwriting, claims, finance, operational, regulatory and strategic audits, with a focus on the European operations.
- Provide support to financial controls testing team as required.
- Establish the objectives, scopes and test plans for audits, execute the procedures, discuss observations with senior management, and prepare audit report.
- Provide executable recommendations that improve operations, controls, and how the business is managed.
- Communicate audit observations, internal control deficiencies, and recommendations, including to senior management.
- Prepare clear and concise draft reports including audit observations.
