### **Duties and Responsibilities**

- Direct handling of 1<sup>st</sup> Party Commercial Property claims across our operating units across the United States within departmental Best Practices.
- Directing independent adjusters and other claim vendors in the successful evaluation and resolution of 1<sup>st</sup> Party Commercial Property claims that are typically issue oriented and complex in accordance with departmental Best Practices.
- Evaluate exposures and make substantive claim decisions for 1<sup>st</sup> Party Commercial Property claims.
- Maintain appropriate file documentation, file notes, claim loss data and financial information in our electronic system of record within departmental Best Practices.
- Selection and management of the proper experts in accordance with departmental protocols to develop and execute on a strategy to resolve assigned claims.
- Keep the underwriting and global claims team current on loss trends and market intelligence. Additionally, you will be expected to provide relevant loss information on claims responsible for driving loss development on your assigned accounts.
- Ensure timely and accurate reporting of exposure to underwriting and management.
- Ensure appropriate narrative and arithmetic reports are timely prepared and disseminated.

- Demonstrated ability to establish close working relationship with other departments including underwriting & actuarial.
- Strong negotiating, analytical, written and organizational skills.
- Strong computer skills (MS Word, Excel, Outlook and various in-house claims systems –Guidewire, Genius, ImageRight is a plus).
- Effective leadership experience regarding direction provided to 3<sup>rd</sup> party vendors assisting with complex loss adjustments.
- Multiple state adjuster licenses a plus.
