The **Senior Technical Specialist, Environmental** position handles environmental claims for Contractors Pollution Liability (CPL), Site Environmental Liability (SEIL) and Excess Environmental Liability (EEL) policies. In addition, this role supports the GRS Environmental Underwriting Team.

**Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Handle GRS Environmental claims and related systems and processes
- Evaluate exposures and make substantive claim decisions for GRS Environmental claims, including first-party and third-party mold and pollution claims
- Proven ability to provide coverage, liability, and damages analysis for complex Environmental claims
- Ability to proactively identify trends and exposures that may affect the GRS portfolio
- Support underwriting with policy drafting and coverage questions
- Ensure timely and accurate reporting of exposure to underwriting and management
- Effectively represent the company at client meetings, mediations, external meetings and industry events.



- As part of the Global Claims Team you will be expected to contribute to the success of the team by working closely with your colleagues worldwide on various projects as directed by the management and other members of Executive Team. This may include attending various industry conferences, possibly as a speaker/presenter, publishing on current claim trends and issues and assisting other offices on complex claims.

**Minimum Qualifications:**

- Minimum of 5-7 years' experience required in claims handling under pollution policies or in combination with law firm, environmental agency or environmental consulting experience.
- Proven ability to provide coverage, liability and damages analysis for complex Environmental claims.
- Strong experience attending mediations and negotiating settlements.
- Experience drafting pollution policies as well as reviewing contracts.
- Ability to establish close working relationship with underwriting, actuarial and legal.
- Excellent presentation, verbal and written communication skills. Candidates may be asked to provide writing samples.
- Analytical, decision making and resource management skills with attention to detail.
- Strong commitment to providing White Glove claims service
- Strong negotiating, analytical, written and organizational skills
- Strong computer skills (MS Word, Excel, Outlook and various in-house claims systems – Guidewire, Genius, ImageRight is a plus)
